

Notice regarding Explanatory Lectures on Library Use for the 2026 Q1 • Q2

Please note the following details regarding these lectures.

1. Period to be held : Monday, April 13, 2026 – Friday, July 17, 2026: Classes are held Monday to Friday
1st Quarter : Monday & Thursday: Periods 1–3/ Tuesday & Friday: Periods 1–4/ Wednesday: Periods 1–2
2nd Quarter : Monday & Thursday: Periods 1–4/ Tuesday & Friday: Periods 1–3/ Wednesday: Periods 1–2
※Not held on Saturdays or Sundays, and in Period 5 between Monday to Friday.
Please ask regarding any other dates.

Please understand that we may not be able to deal with computer problems that occur on the day.

4. Content of lectures

(1)Beginners (How to use the Library and searching for materials)

In order to learn how to find reference materials held in the library we explain the basics of how to use the library and how to search for materials, going as far as actually finding what you are looking for.

- Getting to know the Library (Library information board)
- Using the library (User Guide. How to use MyLibrary)
- Searching for books (Search using OPAC)
(How to search for books or journals. Practice various searches)
- Searching for materials held in the library (Group work)

(2)Intermediate level (How to search for materials that use digital resources)

※For people who are capable of using OPAC.

We explain how to go through the Library website to effectively search for digital materials in order to write reports or theses.

※Please choose from the categories listed below to make a total of 90 minutes.

【DB Overview】

*The 30-minute session has been reduced to only an explanation (no practice search).

*60-minute session

- When you apply to hold the session, please advise of the key words or topics you will use in the database practice.
- In addition to the explanation of the database, CiNii/EBSCOhost will involve practice carrying out searches and searching for materials held in the library.
- Nikkei Telecom21/Westlaw Japan will carry out the database explanation as well as overseeing the practice carrying out searches. (No in-library materials search)

(Note): The 60-minute session on YOMIDAS will include an explanation of the Asahi Shimbun cross search and a practice search. However, because there is limit on the number of days on which the Asahi Shimbun cross search lecture ID number can be used, there may be occasions when we cannot provide this service.

*90-minute session

- CiNii and EBSCOhost provide the same content as the 60-minute session, with an extended hands-on search practice period.
- In addition to database instruction, the 90-minute Westlaw Japan session involves practical search exercises and time to search for materials held in the library.

(3) Providing guidance materials

The instructor in charge of the session should use the guidance materials we provide for the Library User Explanatory Sessions

- Apart from the guidance materials on library use (PowerPoint), we can also provide you with a worksheet. Please let us know if you need anything beyond this.
- Library staff are available to assist as instructors if you are to use the seminar room.
