- We are discontinuing the shelves for magazines in the Browsing Corner and will replace them with a new digital magazine reading service called d-magazine forBiz.
- It will be possible to use the digital magazine reading service d-magazine forBiz in the Library.

9. Library-use for those not affiliated to Nanzan

It will not be possible for people not affiliated to Nanzan to enter the Library and use materials. If such people wish to use our Library holdings they are able to request an interloan through their local library. However, please understand that some of our materials will not be available for interloan while they are in the process of being moved.

- Copying using the micro-reader printer (50 yen per page)
