APPLICATION PROCESS



NOMINATE A STUDENT

Formal nominations should include the student's name (as it appears on their passport), date of birth, nationality, personal email address and gender. Once we receive this information, a temporary profile will be created for the nominee and an invitation email sent directly to them for formal submission of the exchange program application.

You can nominate a student by sending an email to our [incoming exchange coordinators](#).

Partners should only nominate students with a 3.0 GPA or higher (based on the U.S. grading scale) and who have met the English proficiency requirement (as shown on our website).

REVIEW THE PROGRAM COURSES

Students can [search for available courses](#) online.

All classes are taught in English.

UC requires full-time enrollment of 12-18 UC semester credits.

RECEIVE THE DS-2019

Once the student is accepted by the University of Cincinnati, the exchange coordinator will issue their DS-2019 form, which is the document students need to apply for a J-1 visa.

This document is prepared by the International Services office.

The DS-2019 will be emailed electronically to the student.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

- *Fall* | April 1
- *Spring* | October 1

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

- **TOEFL iBT internet:** 79 or above; minimum of 15 reading/listening; minimum 20 writing/speaking
- **IELTS:** 6.5 or above; minimum of 5.5 reading/listening; minimum 6.0 writing/speaking
- **DuoLingo:** 100 overall; minimum of 100 production/conversation

ACCOMMODATIONS

HEALTH INSURANCE

Exchange and visiting students have the option to waive UC's Student Health Insurance if they provide documentation of an external insurance plan that meets the Department of State regulations for J-1 students and scholars. These insurance requirements can be viewed under the J-1 scholars section on our [healthcare and insurance webpage](#).

Note that alternate insurance plans may not cover required immunizations and students will be responsible for any charges not covered. More information will be sent to students about the process to waive UC's Student Health Insurance after being accepted to the program.
