Selecting Courses	Students may register for courses after they receive their UNT I.D. and password and submit a completed course enrollment request form.
	Undergraduates must register for at least 12 credit hours. Undergraduate courses are listed as 1000-4000.
	Graduate students must register for at least 9 credit hours. Graduate courses are listed as 5000-6000.
