Tuitions Changes and Summer Program 2024

1. Summer Program 2024 Focusing on Course A

Our center staff and faculty conducted a review of our programs, considering how best to meet the recent demand and student expectations and needs, alongside how to best integrate our students and programs into the wider campus community and the long-term vision for the university. One conclusion we came to was a need to focus our Summer Program on a single 8-week term closely aligned with the university's second quarter calendar, and eliminate the internship(Course B) and 4-week options(Course C). This will allow us to continue to strengthen our intensive Japanese language courses while simultaneously expanding the elective course options within the program and continuing to develop more courses where the Center for Japanese Studies students and Nanzan University regular students can learn together.

2. Program Tuition Fee Changes from Summer 2024

In response to recent rises in our costs due to inflation, and an increased number of incoming students to be accommodated, we decided we must raise our program tuition fees from Summer 2024. The 8-week summer program fees will rise JPY20,000, to 280,000 for Summer 2024, and full semester tuition fees will rise JPY30,000, to 370,000 per semester for Fall 2024 and Spring 2025. We expect this slight rise to help us to accommodate more students and continue to provide all the students with quality services. Please note that the admission, administrative, and program registration fees will remain the same.
