Collaboration (outline)	<p>This was basic language and intercultural exchange. Each instructor did preparation and practice in advance with their own students. Then, the instructors and all students met together via Zoom, procedures were explained, and then students were put into breakout rooms in groups of three or four students. About 25 minutes of activities in Japanese were followed by about 25 minutes of activities in English, focused on using structures learned in the Business English courses. Finally, all participants returned to the main room for a brief wrap up. On the Nanzan side, there was some immediate follow-up discussion in the classroom after the session.</p>
