Collaboration (outline)	Language and culture exchange between Japanese and English learners. The first meeting was held with Arai-sensei and her upper-level students and the second with Meguro-sensei and first-year students. Students used prompts and general outlines to practice language forms and to gain knowledge about cultural differences and similarities.		
duration	Approximately one-hour sessions two times, with 25 minutes in Japanese and 25 minutes in English spent in small breakout sessions.		
How to evaluate students' achievement	Students submitted a written report on their exchanges, showing what they had learned.
