In those meetings students met in breakout rooms to discuss particular topics, half the time in Japanese and half the time in English. Students changed groups once to give them a second chance to explain or ask questions about these topics. Students wrote discussion questions beforehand which were checked by the instructors to help facilitate the discussion. Students also wrote reflections of their experience after each discussion.
