# **Course Offerings for Exchange Students**

## [Undergraduate Courses]

While exchange students can take courses of different disciplines and majors, some course restrictions apply. Please read the following well and check each course restrictions through Syllabus inquiry.

- Students of all departments including exchange students can take the University-wide General Education Courses and courses offered by a faulty or a department if the courses are open to all departments or all faculties.
- To take a course, students must meet the academic requirements set by the course.
- Some courses such as internships, "seminars (演習)," and compulsory courses for undergraduates are not open to exchange students.
- Exceptions may be considered depending on students' academic performance at their home universities. Please consult our Academic Adviser (<a href="mailto:intl-advising@nanzan-u.ac.jp">intl-advising@nanzan-u.ac.jp</a>) well in advance if you wish to apply to courses other than those mentioned above.
- Most of the courses are conducted in Japanese except for the International Course Category.

#### Keyword Search:

Please type the keyword, and click the search button "検索実行" to search the syllabus using keyword.

NOTE: For most courses, "Course Title (科目名)" and "Course Descriptions (全文)" are in Japanese, except for a few courses conducted in English. You can find more results in Japanese using the keyword search option.




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Syllabus Database System





## **[Graduate Courses]**

In principle, graduate students should choose courses offered under graduate courses at Nanzan. You can search courses offered by each school using the online syllabus inquiry. However, enrollment restrictions for exchange students vary depending on each school.

Please consult our Academic Adviser (intl-advising@nanzan-u.ac.jp) well in advance to check if your desired courses are open to exchange students.

#### **NOTE:**

Students who wish to apply for graduate programs must consult our Academic Adviser to discuss their prospective research Supervisor while at Nanzan. This procedure is a mandatory before application.
