

Summer Program 2021 Announcement

Due to the continuing COVID-19 pandemic, the CJS 2021 Summer Program will not be offered on campus but rather in an online format.

Note that only two of the three Courses will be offered:

Course A – eight weeks of intensive Japanese

Course C – four weeks of intensive Japanese

Course B, with four weeks of intensive Japanese and a four-week company internship, will not be offered this Summer.

For both Course A and Course C, all Japanese Language Courses and both Japan Studies Courses will be offered, along with three Japanese Seminar Course (Business Japanese, Elementary Translation, Writing for Communication) and one Japanese Arts Course (Japanese Dance (*Odori*)). Unfortunately, we cannot offer Open Courses or the other Japanese Arts Courses this Summer.

Students who are taking the present 2021 Spring Semester and who are in Japan will be able to stay in Japan for the 2021 Summer Program; all other students will not be assisted to enter Japan.

The cost and all other conditions of the CJS 2021 Summer Program will remain the same as usual for self-finance students and our partners. Please refer to further information here:
